



## COMMUNITY BASKETBALL LEAGUE Masters 3X3

### Code of Behaviour – Players

- Know and play by the FIBA & CBL rules.
- Never argue with an official
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted behaviour.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether your team or the opposition makes them.
- Treat all participants during the game as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no organized competition in basketball.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Players should have read the Players Code of Conduct before they begin to play.

### Code of Behaviour – Team/Club Administrators

- Ensure that all players know the CBL Rules & Regulations.
- Ensure that your members behave in an appropriate manner on and off the court. Approaching a member of the opposition team, a spectator or/and an official in an inappropriate manner at any time is COMPLETELY UNACCEPTABLE. Obviously, approaching anyone to say, for example, 'Job well done, thank you for the game' etc., is acceptable and strongly encouraged.
- Ensure that everyone involved in basketball emphasizes fair play.
- Ensure that all players adhered to the codes of conduct at all times! It's the club administrator's responsibility to monitor its club members, players and spectators behavior, and take preventative measures to ensure a safe playing environment for all players.
- It's the club administrator's responsibility to submit all required hard or soft copy documents, team and player registration forms, and that all the clubs/teams members are aware of the codes of conduct.

### Code of Behaviour – Spectators

- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities. Respect officials' decisions and teach others to do likewise.
- Show appreciation for officials and administrators. Without them, your teams could not participate in basketball.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Players and other spectators are to respect each other at all times, during and after the games.
- Under **NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD A SPECTATOR ENTER THE PLAYING COURT, APPROACH AN OFFICIAL, OPPOSITION PLAYER OR COACH** before, during or after the game.
